

SYNCHRONIZED PREDEPLOYMENT AND OPERATIONAL TRACKER - ENTERPRISE SUITE (SPOT-ES)

WHAT IS SPOT 7.3.2?

The SPOT 7.3.2 release will accommodate specific operational requirements for the United States Central Command (USCENTCOM) Area of Responsibility (AOR). When a contract or task order requires a Theater Business Clearance (TBC), it is now mandatory to enter the issued TBC Number. Additionally, the Company Managed Equipment feature has been expanded to include detailed information needed for tracking contractor managed equipment.

■ Theater Business Clearance (TBC) Number Required

TBC policy, as defined by the USCENTCOM-Joint Theater Support Contracting Command (C-JTSCC), requires Contracting Officers to obtain Combatant Command clearance before soliciting and awarding DoD contracts or task orders that require performance in or delivery of material to specified countries in the USCENTCOM AOR. Upon TBC approval, a TBC number is issued confirming the contract or task order has been cleared and is compliant with TBC rules and regulations.

Beginning with SPOT 7.3.2, when **Yes** is selected for **Theater Business Clearance Required?** the **Theater Business Clearance Number** field, which dynamically appears, will require the TBC number to be entered for contracts or task orders.

■ United States Forces-Afghanistan (USFOR-A) Demobilization Support

The SPOT 7.3.2 release is supporting United States Forces-Afghanistan (USFOR-A) in identifying contractor managed equipment and shipping containers within Afghanistan. Company Administrators may begin entering specific information pertaining to equipment targeted for shipment.

The Company Managed Equipment feature now includes **Container Number** as part of the label to the existing field labeled **Serial Number/VIN**. Additional fields such as: **Equipment Category**, **Estimated Ship Date**, and **Remarks** allow clarifying information. Maintaining this information will allow resources the ability to track equipment in containers and provide consolidated location information regarding equipment in Afghanistan.
