Document No. 02-32.

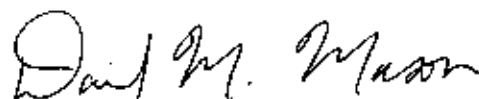
The motion carried on the vote of 4-0 with Commissioners Mason, Sandstrom, Smith, and Thomas voting affirmatively.
