The technician must be familiar with the various code requirements applicable to fire alarm and clean agent fire suppression systems, and be capable of installing systems in compliance with code requirements, employer policies, end user requirements, system manufacturer requirements, safety requirements and project specifications.</p> <p>Special Hazards Fire Suppression System Technician will be added to the list of occupations recognized as apprenticeable by OA when the list is reissued.
