

## Actions

What do spiders, snakes, and all things that bite have in common? They are all hidden dangers we experience every day during the course of our work.







## Note:



If you are allergic to bee stings, etc., consult your physician for advice on immediate treatment and tell your coworkers what help you might need if stung.



Know your areas and locations where bees nest and take precautions when in those areas.

## Things to REMEMBER:

- Even though most snakes are not poisonous, do not pick up or play with any snake.
- Do not put your hands or feet into any area you cannot see.
- Be a ware of dark spaces where critters like to hide.
- If bitten or stung and breathing difficulties develop, or if someone else appears to be bitten and is having an adverse reaction, GET HELP!
- To protect yourself from bites and stings wear long pants, socks, and long-sleeved shirts.
- Stings from bees, hornets, and wasps cause more deaths than bites from all other insects and spiders.
