WEARING OF ROK-US COMBINED FORCES COMMAND (CFC) BADGE
AND
BILINGUAL NAMEPLATES**

1. **PURPOSE.** To prescribe the policy on the wearing of the CFC badge and bilingual nameplates.
2. **APPLICABILITY.** This memorandum is applicable to all United States (US) and Republic of Korea (ROK) military personnel assigned for duty to the Headquarters (HQs) staff, ROK-US CFC.
3. **POLICY.**
 - a. The CFC badge (with raised stars and laurel branch) will be worn as outlined below:
 - (1) The CFC badge will be worn by all ROK and US military personnel assigned to HQs CFC. US military personnel who serve primarily in another command but who also fill HQs CFC positions (dual status) are expected to wear the CFC badge.
 - (2) There are only two sizes of the CFC badge authorized for wear (appendix A). The standard size badge will be worn on the service uniform and on the utility (battle dress) uniform when in garrison. The miniature badge will be worn on the shirt and may be worn on the sweater when worn as an outer garment without the appropriate uniform coat or jacket.
 - (3) The badge (with clasp) will be attached to the left breast pocket beneath the flap on the service uniform. The badge (with leather strap) will be attached to the left breast pocket button beneath the flap on the utility uniform and shirt. The badge will be worn on the left affixed by a clasp on uniforms with no left pocket or pocket flap. Military personnel who wear the sweater as an outer garment should consult their appropriate service regulation for placement of the miniature badge on the sweater. Should national service badges and emblems be required for wear on the left breast pocket, the CFC badge will be worn centered beneath the right breast pocket flap. Wearing of the CFC badge is optional if national service badges and emblems are displayed on both uniform breast pockets.
 - (4) Persons serving in dual status positions on both the United Nations Command (UNC) and the CFC staffs may wear both the UNC and CFC identification badges provided no other badges or national service emblems are worn on the military uniform breast pockets. If both of the badges are worn, the CFC badge will be worn on the left pocket and the UNC badge will be worn on the right pocket.

(5) Authorization to wear the CFC badge terminates when an individual detaches or is transferred from Headquarters CFC.

b. Bilingual nameplates may be worn by all personnel assigned to HQs CFC for duty. The wearing of dual language nameplates assists ROK and US personnel in pronouncing the sometimes difficult Korean and American names. Bilingual nameplates also emphasize the combined nature of CFC.

4. PROCUREMENT PROCEDURES. a. Procurement of the standard size CFC badge will be made through respective national supply channels.

b. Procurement of the bilingual nameplates may be purchased by each individual.
