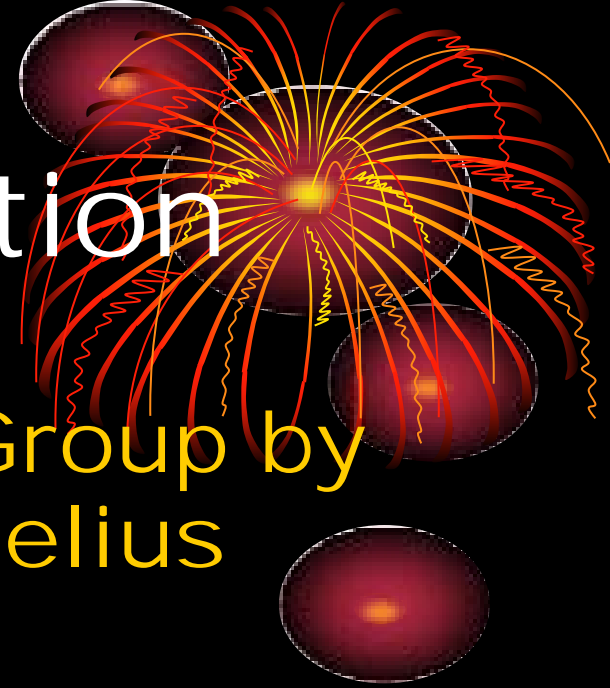

Indian Policy

LAW – ARRA Sec.5006(e)



- the State seeks advice on a regular, ongoing basis from designees of such Indian Health Programs and Urban Indian Organizations on matters relating to the application of this title that are likely to have a direct effect on such Indian Health Programs and Urban Indian Organizations

- To assist States in the development and implementation of mechanisms for consultation with their respective tribal governments and Indian organizations before taking actions that will affect these governments and/or the Indian people residing within their state. Consultation should be conducted in a meaningful manner that is consistent with the definition of "consultation" as defined in this policy,

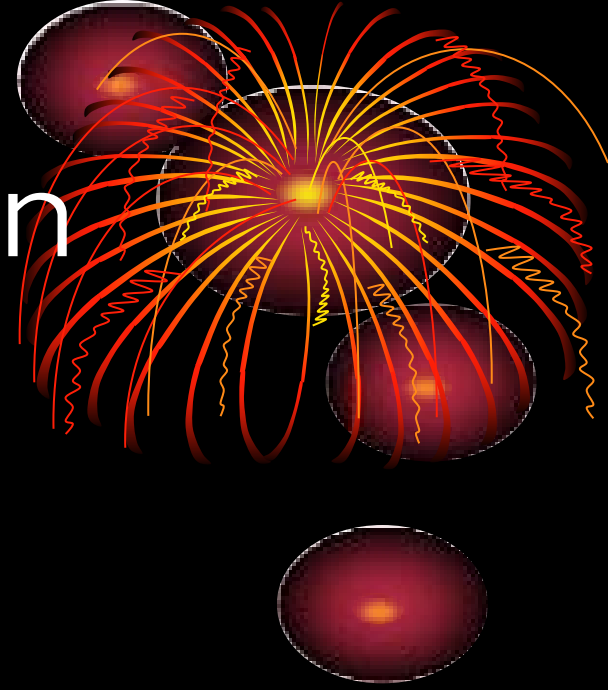


State Obligated to establish two consultation groups
