HISTORY

- The current revised Contract Support policy was modified and took effect in 2007.
 Effective for 2007 through 2010 funding periods.
- At the end of fiscal year 2010 funding period the revised CSC allocation methodology was to be evaluated to determine if the changes should be made permanent.

CURRENT RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Provide training and education to Tribes.
- Add Tribal Consultation to the policy prior to the Headquarters finalizing the reports for Congress.
- Change reporting requirements.
 - Tribes should be allowed to review their own data prior to submission to Headquarters.
- Change CSC inflation adjustment from nonmedical to medical inflation rate.

QUESTIONS:

- Should the shortfall of existing programs be addressed (paid) prior to new and expanded programs?
- Do Tribes want their information shared with all Tribes or should it be confidential?
