The Indian Health Service (IHS) plans to build a Youth Regional Treatment Center at 39990 Faure Road, Hemet, CA (Taylor Ranch). On October 17, IHS presented to the Hemet community its plan, including draft findings from the Environmental Assessment.

The National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 USC § 4321) requires Federal agencies to evaluate the impact of their actions on the environment.
