

Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT) KICKSTART:

Do you need to raise your GT score? Could your career use a jumpstart? The Area 1 Education Centers are offering a new program designed to help Soldiers improve their GT score and kick start or continue your college education.

The Education Center in conjunction with a UMUC is offering a new program designed to improve your GT score and help start on the road to higher education. The program will allow you to enroll in two college courses (Math and English) for a total of six credits. If enrolled in the program, UMUC will waive any application fee and the education center will loan you the book for the class. So not only will you work on improving your GT, it will cost you nothing but your time and effort.

The program requires you to take the TABE (Test for Adult Basic Education) before and after the classes. Also required is an online study program offered by Petersons online education. The test will help us determine what skills you need help with to improve your Basic English and Math skills. The Online Academic Skills Course (OASC) is designed specifically to help you on the Armed Forces Classification Test and to raise your GT scores.
