Formally established on March 5, 1942, the Naval Construction Battalions or Seabees arose from the military's growing need for base construction. During World War II, nearly 325,000 men served as Seabees, building and fighting in both the Atlantic and Pacific Theaters. Despite often having to work under strenuous conditions, World War II era Seabees became known for their "Can Do!" attitude and their ability to complete construction projects quickly, efficiently, and with creativity. Today, Seabees in more than forty-nine countries around the globe are carrying on the proud tradition of their predecessors.
