As someone who may be using **Novolin® InnoLet®** disposable insulin pens or **Novolin® PenFill®** 3mL insulin cartridges, it is important for you to know that these insulin delivery options are being discontinued. Only these insulin delivery devices will no longer be available.

After this discontinuation, pharmacies may continue to stock **Novolin® InnoLet®** disposable insulin pens and **Novolin® PenFill®** 3mL insulin cartridges, but they will not receive any new inventory. Final date of sale of the products is December 31, 2009. Therefore, we encourage you to speak with your doctor about alternatives if you are currently using the following specific products:

- **Novolin® R InnoLet®** (Regular, Human Insulin Injection [recombinant DNA origin] USP in a 3 mL disposable prefilled insulin syringe)
- Novolin® N InnoLet® (NPH, Human Insulin Isophane Suspension [recombinant DNA origin] in a 3 mL disposable prefilled insulin syringe)
- Novolin® 70/30 InnoLet® (70% NPH, Human Insulin Isophane Suspension and 30% Regular, Human Insulin Injection [recombinant DNA origin] in a 3 mL disposable prefilled insulin syringe)
- Novolin® R PenFill® 3 mL cartridges (Regular, Human Insulin Injection [recombinant DNA origin] USP)
- Novolin® N PenFill® 3 mL cartridges (NPH, Human Insulin Isophane Suspension [recombinant DNA origin])
- Novolin® 70/30 PenFill® 3 mL cartridges (70% NPH, Human Insulin Isophane Suspension and 30% Regular, Human Insulin Injection [recombinant DNA origin])
