COMMANDANT INSTRUCTION M5210.5D

Subj: Standard Subject Identification Codes (SSIC) Manual

1. PURPOSE. This Manual transmits Standard Subject Identification Codes for the Coast Guard.
2. DIRECTIVES AFFECTED. COMDTINST M5210.5C is cancelled.
3. MAJOR CHANGES. The following categories have been added:
  - 2600 - COMTAC Matters
  - 12849 - Thrift Savings Plan
  - 16236 - MAPDET Units
  - 16248 - AEROSTAT
4. ACTION. Area and district commanders, commanders of maintenance and logistics commands, unit commanding officers, and Commander, CG Activities Europe shall ensure that the SSICs (transmitted as enclosure (1)), shall be used by the Coast Guard.
5. CHANGES. Recommended changes to series codes 1000 - 13000 may be submitted to Commandant (G-TIS) for forwarding to the Navy for a decision. Recommended changes to series code 16000 may be submitted to Commandant (G-TIS) for a decision.

Subj: DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY FILE MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES AND  
STANDARD SUBJECT IDENTIFICATION CODES (SSIC)

1. Purpose. To revise the Department of the Navy Standard Subject Identification Codes and the Department of the Navy File Maintenance Procedures.
2. Cancellation. SECNAVINST 5210.11C
3. Policy. This instruction outlines the process for segregating and filing Navy and Marine Corps records and the single standard system of numbers and/or letter symbols used throughout the Department of the Navy for categorizing and subject classifying Navy and Marine Corps information. SSICs are required on all Navy and Marine Corps letters, messages, directives, forms and reports. Only approved codes will be assigned; however, expansion of the system for filing purposes is authorized following the file maintenance procedures.
4. Maintenance and Revision. The Naval Data Automation Command (Code 81) maintains the system and provides for changes. Submit recommendations for changes to NAVDAC (Code 81) following guidance in Section 5.
5. Forms. Cross-Reference, OF-21, NSN 7540-00-823-8128; Chargeout Record, OF-23, NSN 7540-00-823-8130; Shelf File Chargeout Record (Letter Size), OF-24, NSN 7540-00-823-8131 and Shelf File Chargeout Record (Legal Size), OF-25, NSN 7540-00-823-8132 are available through the Federal supply system, GSA supply depots, or local GSA stores.

**SECTION 1**

**FILING PROCEDURES**

1. **Background.** The size and complexity of the Navy demands standard methods for filing paperwork. Standardization frees personnel from learning new filing systems when moving from one activity to another.
2. **Filing procedures.** To maintain files effectively and economically follow these procedures.
  - a. **File Location and Control.** Maintain a central control of activity files. Your central control should:
    - (1) Assign personnel to coordinate all activity files
    - (2) Authorize official files and assign responsibility for files plans
    - (3) Locate the official at an organizational level that ensures effective documentation, makes records accessible to major users, minimizes duplicate files and aids records disposal.
    - (4) Determine records retention and disposal standards using SECNAVINST 5212.5C and apply to each file series and prepare local disposal instructions.
    - (5) Perform periodic reviews of the files procedures.
  - b. **File Material.** Do not include unnecessary working papers, early drafts, extra copies, or information material as part of the file material. Include the following
    - (1) The incoming document
    - (2) Copy of the outgoing correspondence
    - (3) Any essential supporting documents
  - c. **File Maintenance.** File material loose in folders unless you need fasteners to hold pages in a particular order. Use prong fasteners rather than staples, clips or rubber bands to hold material.
3. **Cross-referencing.** When a document concerns more than one subject, name or case, file an extra copy under each subject and give the location of the basic document on each copy. If extra copies are not available, use a Cross Reference Sheet (OF-21).
4. **Charging Out Files.** Keep track of all documents removed from files. When a document or an entire file is removed, put a charge out slip in its place. If the document is transferred among several people update the charge out slip. Optional Forms 23, 24, and 25 can be used as charge out slips.
5. **Closing Files.** Close general correspondence files at the end of each calendar year. Close budget and accounting files at the end of each fiscal year. Some other files, most often case files, stay current until an action ends or event occurs. Hold

closed files locally in an inactive status until destruction or transfer to a Federal Records Center using standards in SECNAVINST 5212.5C.

**SECTION 2**

**CONSTRUCTION OF STANDARD SUBJECT  
IDENTIFICATION CODES (SSIC)**

1. **SSICs Required.** An SSIC is a four-or-five-digit number that stands for the subject of a document. SSICs are required on all Navy and Marine Corps letters, messages, directives, forms and reports. The use of SSICs provides a tested method for filing documents consistently and retrieving them quickly.
2. **SSICs.** The Navy's SSIC system is broken down into 13 major subject groups. These major subject groups are then broken down into primary, secondary, and tertiary subdivisions. Primary subjects are designated by the last three digits of the code number. For example, here are three of the primary subdivisions under General Administration and Management, whose major subject group code is 5000.

General categories use zeros  
5000 General Administration and Management

This is an example of a primary subject  
5200 Management Programs and Techniques

The last two digits designate secondary subjects  
5210 Records Management

The last digit reflects a tertiary subject  
5211 Filing, Maintenance, Protection, Retrieval, and Privacy  
Act Systems

Some subject groups are not subdivided below the primary breakdown. Some groups are divided into many secondary and tertiary subjects depending on the complexity of the major subject.

3. **ASSIGNING the Right SSIC to a Document.** When you create a document, include the SSIC that most closely describes the document's subject. When assigning the code, consider the subject, the purpose or significance, and the manner in which similar documents are requested and the code used for similar documents.
4. **Arranging Files by SSIC.** When you close one year's files and start new files, make up files for the SSICs that are likely to occur most often,. Add new folders later on as documents with new SSICs arrive for filing. The SSICs listed in section 3 provide all the divisions that most activities need to keep their files manageable. However, large activities may have to supplement this directive using the guidance on subdividing SSICs. Paragraph 5 below shows ways to subdivide SSICs.
5. **Subdividing SSICs.** When subdivisions of SSICs are necessary for local file purposes, you may use the SSIC with an SNDL code, additional numbers or words, two SSICs, or combinations of these. Some examples of each are as follows:

**SECTION 5**

**GUIDELINES FOR REQUESTING CHANGES**

1. Submit recommendations for changes (additions, deletions and modifications) to Director, Naval Data Automation Command (Code 81), Washington, DC 20374-1662.
2. Provide the following information:
  - a. SSIC number (present number or recommended number)
  - b. Current subject (if applicable)
  - c. Recommended subject (for additions and modifications,)
  - d. Related areas (cite any applicable system, procedure, technical term, and/or any acronym which might apply.
  - e. Justification for the request.
3. Use the following guidelines when considering a change to an existing number, a deletion, or a new number.
  - a. Any subject that has relevance to a large segment of the Navy may be recommended provided it does not duplicate or identify with a closely related existing subject.
  - b. Accurately identify a proper placement of new subjects by ensuring that the functional major subject grouping, primary subject grouping, secondary subject grouping and tertiary number are all in logical functional sequence.
  - c. Narrative subject titles should be functionally descriptive, have broad definition and be stated concisely.
  - d. New words or subject titles closely related to an existing SSIC may be submitted for insertion in Section 4 of the Manual (alphabetical guide), along with the associated numerical code.
  - e. If a numerical code is deleted, the number cannot be used for a different narrative subject.
