Active Guard Reserve Program provides opportunities for enlisted Soldiers

FORT KNOX, Ky. – Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Soldiers serve full time and enjoy the same benefits and entitlements as active-duty Soldiers, including: full pay, medical care for themselves and their immediate families, and the opportunity for retirement after 20 years of active service.

Soldiers serving within the AGR Program are stationed worldwide in positions that directly support the Army Reserve. The enlisted AGR program is primarily looking for high-quality Soldiers within the ranks of specialist and sergeant first class in the following areas: Adjutant General; Army Nurse Corps; Aviation; Chemical Corps; Civil Affairs; Engineer; Finance; Judge Advocate General's Corps; Medical Service Corps; Military Intelligence; Military Police; Ordnance; Public Affairs; Quartermaster; Recruiting; Signal; and Transportation.

AGR Accessions has moved to Fort Knox to consolidate with the rest of HRC. There is no need for a paper application; basic qualifications may be found in Army Regulation 135-18, Chapter 2. Those interested can submit applications online through AKO-https://www.hrc.army.mil/portal/. Navigate to the My Record Portal in "Tools," and find "AGR Application." It does require an AKO password and/or CAC.
