U.S. Army Human Resources Command to uncase command flag Friday Command begins operations at Fort Knox, Kentucky

Media are invited to attend the U.S. Army Human Resources Command (HRC) "Uncasing of the Colors" ceremony Friday at its new headquarters, the Human Resource Center of Excellence, Fort Knox, Ky.

In accordance with the 2005 Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission (BRAC) Report, the U.S. Army Human Resources Command (HRC) is consolidating and relocating operations from Alexandria, Va., Indianapolis, Ind., and St. Louis, Mo. to Fort Knox, Ky.

The casing and uncasing of the colors is an Army tradition symbolizing the movement of an organization to a new area of operation. On June 16, HRC's distinctive flag, or "colors," were furled, or "cased," in a protective sheath for transport from Alexandria, Va. to the Human Resource Center of Excellence. HRC will uncase its colors June 25 at its new home.
