OCS Operations Safety Alert

Stem Blowout of Grove B-4 Ball Valves

Two incidents were recently reported by an operator in which the stems of Grove B-4 ball valves blew out while attempting to close the valves. Excessive torque was required to close the valves, which resulted in shearing the pins holding the stems in place. Fortunately, only very minor injury to personnel occurred, with no damage to the property or environment.
