SUBJECT: HRC Schedule

Between now and the health reform announcement date, there will be four kinds of interest group related meetings or events HRC will probably need to do:

- 1. "Deal closing" meetings/events. We have been doing some of these the last couple of months. For now, I would recommend that there isn't much more we can do to close deals, because groups are too edgy until they know the details of the plan. As we get into the last couple of weeks, and after we know the plan's final details, there will need to be a flurry of deal closing meetings.
- 2. Hand holding meetings/events with base groups. We are having a hard time right now keeping our troops lined up. Labor and single payer groups seem especially edgy right now, so I'm pushing those pieces for when she gets back (see attached memoranda.) Depending on which round of rumors makes the rounds next, we may need to schedule some more of these kinds of meetings.
- 3. Softening the bite of our enemies. There are a number of hostile groups or people that have particular juice with key segments of Congress. While we will never be able to win these constituencies over, for HRC to never have met with them will give swing members of Congress an excuse to be against us that we don't want them to have. We've already done one of these meetings (Independent Insurance Agents of America), and it genuinely seems to have softened them. The other requests I would put in this category:
 - Health Insurance Agents of America (Will Gradison)
 - Federation of America Health Systems (Michael Bromberg, for profit hospitals)
 - Ralph Nader

4. Non health related business meetings. We should keep a steady stream of influential CEOs, of both big and small businesses, meeting with her. The more we can work the business community prior to announcement, the better off we will be in terms of getting some of their support. Some of these meetings are already in the works (see attached memo). I will continue to periodically request these kinds of meetings.

SUBJECT: Union Meetings

In the never ending battle to keep nerves calm among our base groups, I would like to schedule a few meetings between small groups of union Presidents and Mrs. Clinton. With the rumor mill working overtime, there are rumblings of nervousness from key unions about the health plan.

I think it would go a long way to do three different sets of meetings with small groups of union Presidents that neither HRC nor Ira has met with yet individually. I would divide them into three categories:

- 1. <u>Single payer oriented industrial unions.</u> I would include Teamsters, Machinists, Communications Workers of America, UAW, International Ladies Garment Workers Union and American Clothing and Textile Workers Union.
- 2. <u>Unions with Taft-Hartley plans</u>. I would include United Food and Commercial Workers, Bricklayers, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Carpenters, and Laborers.
- 3. <u>Federal employee unions</u>. Includes American Federation of Government Employees, Postal Workers, and Letter Carriers.

These meetings don't need to happen until late July or August. Just scheduling them now for August would make people very happy.
