After reviewing the charts we prepared for your small business briefing book, you asked to see a distribution of contributions for all firm sizes; you wanted to see how large businesses fared under our current reform assumptions/model. I asked Jennifer Smith to prepare the attached bar chart -- using Ken Thorpe's most recent numbers -- to respond to your request.

As you will note, all businesses currently providing health insurance to their employees -- even large firms -- will, on average, see their financial burden reduced. (It is always important to stress that these numbers are based on averages and a range of assumptions that may be disputed by some; and, in any case, there certainly will be firms who will still see their health care costs go up). Regardless, however, the numbers portrayed in the chart are obviously very encouraging.

The first-run of the distribution tables -- by income brackets -- have been run by Ken and reviewed by Ira; it is my hope that we can incorporate them into a user-friendly graphic and chart presentation. Using the new figures, I believe we will be able to run a whole range of case examples for the Members of Congress to make them feel much more comfortable with our current policy. We will get you this information as soon as it is available.
