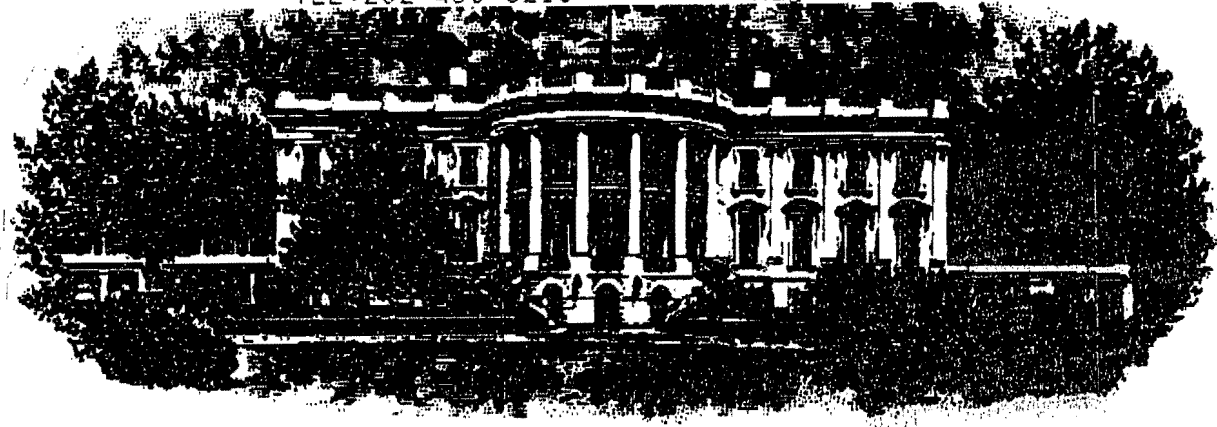

As we discussed, we're interested in having our national board briefed on health care reform and appropriate related issues during its June meeting here in Washington June 10- 13. Ideally, we'd like to have Hillary Clinton play a role in that event.

I'm enclosing copies of the letters I sent to Alexis and to the First Lady's scheduler. Understanding that getting through the next 48 hours is always more important than scheduling something 10 weeks away, I'd appreciate it if you'd keep us in mind and get us a tentative yes -- subject to all the usual caveats -- as quickly as possible. We're prepared to schedule our meeting around your needs as best we can, but that means we have to keep three or four days up in the air, so you can appreciate our need for pinning down as many pieces as possible soon.

Dear Alexis:

Planned Parenthood's national board will meet in Washington June 10 - 13 for the first time since the election and the refreshing new climate. Would it be possible to bring them to the White House at an agreed-upon time during that meeting for a briefing by Ira Magaziner, Carol Rasco or some other appropriate person on health care reform?

We're talking about 45 people, more or less. (When I was at AFSCME and Jimmy Carter was president, we did this with our national board on a couple of occasions, squeezing our board into the Roosevelt Room or somewhere and having someone feed them information and ask for support.) If the President or Ms. Clinton could drop by for a minute or two, that would make it even more spectacular.

We will adapt as best we can to your scheduling needs, but Thursday afternoon, June 10, or midday Friday, June 11, would be our preferences. Please give me some indication of what's possible as soon as you can.
