I am sorry I missed you by phone today.

Today George has shared with me your letter faxed to him of 11/5/93. Both the AIDS Policy Office and my department have strong recommendations into the scheduling office supporting a major AIDS speech Dec. 1. Scheduling for that period will occur soon now that we have a better "feel" for the ending of the Congressional session. I have asked that your letter go with the proposal.

Mrs. Clinton has shared with me your recent concerns. I do hope you will feel free to call me at any time or make an appointment with me the next time you will be in DC. I believe I have always tried to return your calls in a timely way although I recognize there has been some phone tag involved. Also, I don't feel we have ever been able to sit and really talk in a way that will convince you of my concern for this field; it is not one in which I am totally uneducated, and my concern is readily evidenced by the work we did on this out of the governor's office in Arkansas, both at a state level and through the National Governors' Association during then-Governor Clinton's tenure as chairman. I am the first to admit, however, that there is a great deal I can always learn on any topic. I do hope we will have a chance to have a real visit in the very near future.
