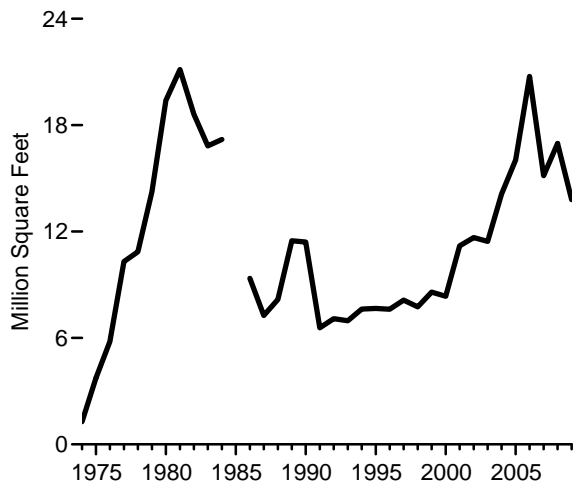
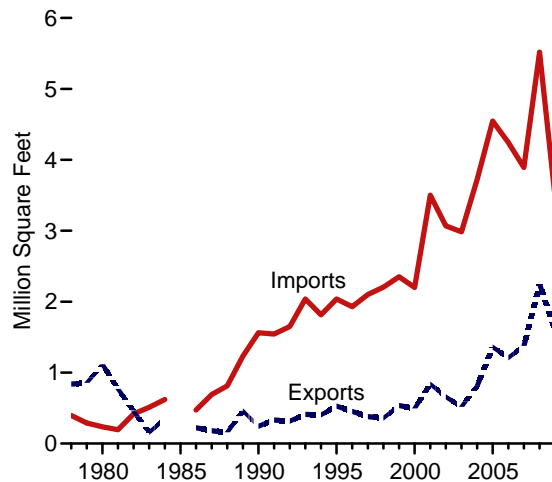


**Figure 10.6 Solar Thermal Collector Shipments by Type, Price, and Trade**

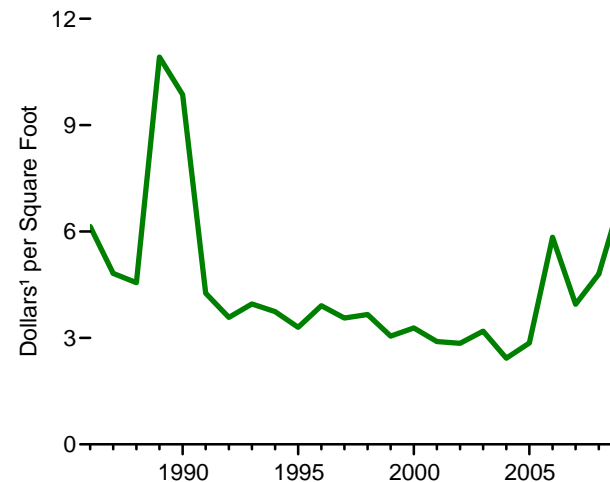
**Total Shipments, 1974-1984 and 1986-2009**



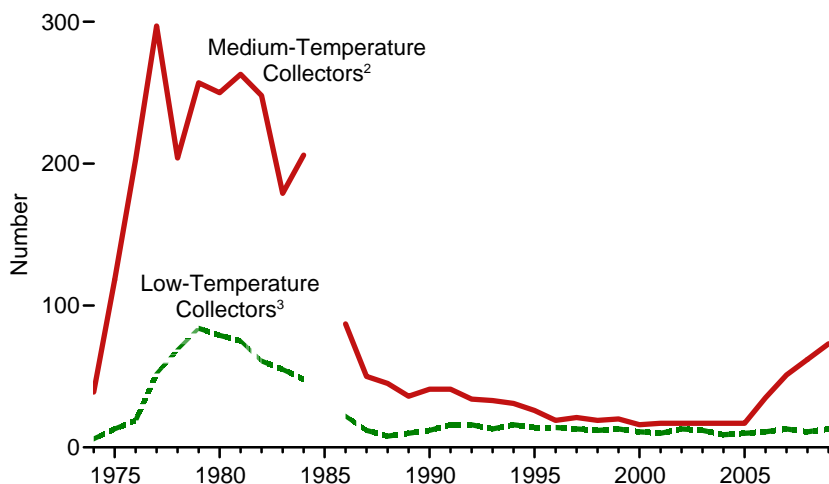
**Trade, 1978-1984 and 1986-2009**



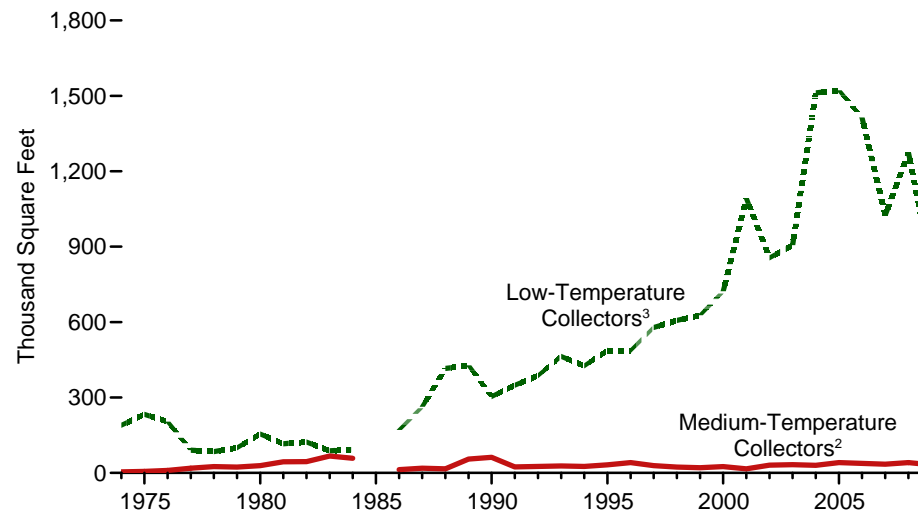
**Price of Total Shipments, 1986-2009**
