NRC TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON PALO VERDE NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with Arizona Public Service Co. officials on Dec. 18 to discuss the status of performance improvements at the Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station. APS operates the plant, located 55 miles west of Phoenix, Ariz.

The meeting, which will be open to public observation, will begin at 1 p.m. at the NRC's Region IV office at 612 E. Lamar Blvd., Suite 400, Arlington, Texas 76011.

APS officials will present a briefing on the status of performance improvements at Palo Verde. The public will have an opportunity to observe and ask questions of NRC staff before the meeting is adjourned.
