## NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET NOV. 3 - 5 IN ROCKVILLE, MD

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) will hold a public meeting Nov. 3-5 in Rockville, Md., to discuss several issues of interest. Meeting topics include:

- Nine Mile Point nuclear power plant Unit 2 extended power uprate; and
- Staff position on guidance for the evaluation of diversity and defense-in-depth in digital computer-based instrumentation and control systems used in operating nuclear reactors.

The meeting will be held in Room T2-B1 of the NRC headquarters location at 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Md. The sessions on Nov. 3 and 4 will run from 8:30 a.m. to 7 p.m., and on Nov. 5 from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Portions of the meeting may be closed to discuss information that includes classified, proprietary, or personnel matters. A complete [ACRS agenda](#) is available on the NRC website.
