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**MEMORANDUM**

**Subject:** Full Committee Markup

On **Wednesday, February 29, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in 1324 Longworth House Office Building**, the Committee on Natural Resources will hold a markup on the following bills:

- **HR 491**, To modify the boundaries of Cibola National Forest in the State of New Mexico, to transfer certain Bureau of Land Management land for inclusion in the national forest, and for other purposes.
- **HR 1038**, To authorize the conveyance of two small parcels of land within the boundaries of the Coconino National Forest containing private improvements that were developed based upon the reliance of the landowners in an erroneous survey conducted in May 1960.
- **HR 1335**, To revise the boundaries of the Gettysburg National Military Park to include the Gettysburg Train Station, and for other purposes.
- **HR 2050**, To authorize the continued use of certain water diversions located on National Forest System land in the Frank Church-River of No Return Wilderness and the Selway-Bitterroot Wilderness in the State of Idaho, and for other purposes. *“Idaho Wilderness Water Resources Protection Act”*
- **HR 2157**, To facilitate a land exchange involving certain National Forest System lands in the Inyo National Forest, and for other purposes.
- **HR 2240**, To authorize the exchange of land or interest in land between Lowell National Historical Park and the city of Lowell in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and for other purposes. *“Lowell National Historical Park Land Exchange Act of 2011”*
- **HR 2489**, To authorize the acquisition and protection of nationally significant battlefields and associated sites of the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812 under the American Battlefield Protection Program. *“American Battlefield Protection Program Amendments Act of 2011”*
- **HR 2512**, To provide for the conveyance of certain Federal land in Clark County, Nevada, for the environmental remediation and reclamation of the Three Kids Mine Project Site, and for other purposes. *“Three Kids Mine Remediation and Reclamation Act”*
- **HR 2745**, To amend the Mesquite Lands Act of 1986 to facilitate implementation of a multispecies habitat conservation plan for the Virgin River in Clark County, Nevada.
- **HR 2947**, To provide for the release of the reversionary interest held by the United States in certain land conveyed by the United States in 1950 for the establishment of an airport in Cook County, Minnesota.
- **HR 3263**, To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to allow the storage and conveyance of nonproject water at the Norman project in Oklahoma, and for other purposes. *“Lake Thunderbird Efficient Use Act of 2011”*

- **HR 3409**, To limit the authority of the Secretary of the Interior to issue regulations before December 31, 2013, under the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977. “*Coal Miner Employment and Domestic Energy Infrastructure Protection Act*”
- **HR 3411**, To modify a land grant patent issued by the Secretary of the Interior.
- **HR 3440**, To provide for certain oversight and approval on any decisions to close National Monument land under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management to recreational shooting, and for other purposes. “*Recreational Shooting Protection Act*”
- **HR 3452**, To provide for the sale of approximately 30 acres of Federal land in Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest in Salt Lake County, Utah, to permit the establishment of a minimally invasive transportation alternative for skiers, called "SkiLink", to connect two ski resorts in the Wasatch Mountains, and for other purposes. “*Wasatch Range Recreation Access Enhancement Act*”
- **HR \_\_\_** (Miller of FL), To protect and enhance opportunities for recreational hunting, fishing and shooting. “*Sportsmen’s Heritage Act of 2012*”
- **S. 271**, A bill to require the Secretary of Agriculture to enter into a property conveyance with the city of Wallowa, Oregon, and for other purposes. “*Wallowa Forest Service Compound Conveyance Act*”
- **S. 292**, A bill to resolve the claims of the Bering Straits Native Corporation and the State of Alaska to land adjacent to Salmon Lake in the State of Alaska and to provide for the conveyance to the Bering Straits Native Corporation of certain other public land in partial satisfaction of the land entitlement of the Corporation under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act. “*Salmon Lake Land Selection Resolution Act*”
- **S. 404**, A bill to modify a land grant patent issued by the Secretary of the Interior.
- **S. 684**, A bill to provide for the conveyance of certain parcels of land to the town of Alta, Utah.
- **S. 897**, A bill to amend the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 to clarify that uncertified States and Indian tribes have the authority to use certain payments for certain noncoal reclamation projects and acid mine remediation programs.
