Authorization for the Release of Information

The data in the EIV system includes private and confidential information. Staff at Public Housing Agencies (PHAs) and PHA-hired private management agents may not view private information unless there is a signed Authorization for the Release of Information and Privacy Act Notice (Form HUD-9886) or equivalent consent form satisfying requirements under 24 CFR 5.230 in the household's file for the head of household and the spouse of the head of household, or co-head, regardless of age, and for each adult member in the household.







Effective Use of EIV Reports

To Identify & Reduce Improper Payments

Use of EIV to Reduce Improper Payments

- Use of EIV reports reduces improper payments
- Specifically, reports assist with the identification of deficiencies & potential improper payments
- PHAs are required to monitor various EIV reports on a monthly and quarterly basis & promptly address and correct all identified deficiencies

PHA Required Monitoring of EIV & PIC Reports - Monthly

- EIV Reports:
 - Deceased Tenants Report
 - Identity Verification Report
 - Failed EIV Pre-Screening
 - Failed SSA Identity Test
 - Immigration Report
- PIC Reports:
 - PIC Delinquency Report
 - PIC Reexam Report

Required Monitoring of EIV Reports - Quarterly

- Multiple Subsidy Report
- New Hires Report
 - Only if your agency has an interim increase policy and modifies family rent contribution in between annual reexams

HUD Monitoring of PHA Program Compliance

Mandated Use of the EIV System 24 CFR 5.233

HUD Monitoring of PHAs

- REAC notified PHAs of routine monitoring of PIC & EIV reports in March 2010
- REAC will notify PHAs and/or local HUD offices of deficiencies by email on a quarterly basis:
 - October report as of 09/30
 - January report as of 12/31
 - April report as of 3/31
 - July report as of 6/30

HUD Monitoring of PHAs (Continued)

- All notices are sent via email to the PHA Executive Director & HUD Field Office Director (and HUD staff)
- Please be sure to promptly forward the notice to designated staff for follow-up

REAC-Monitored Reports

- What REAC monitors:
 - PIC Delinquency Report
 - PIC Reexam Report
 - EIV PHA Usage Report
 - EIV Deceased Tenants Report
 - EIV Identity Verification Report
 - EIV Multiple Subsidy Report
 - EIV Immigration Report
 - EIV Income Report
 - Tenant Unreported Income

PHA Required Actions

- Promptly review the applicable PIC and/or EIV reports
- Correct erroneous information reported on form HUD-50058
- Successfully submit updated 50058s to PIC
- Provide PHA Code & HUD-requested certification statement and documentation (if applicable) to:
 PIH.ImproperPayments@hud.gov by specified due date

Tips for Successful Resolution of Deficiencies

- Read HUD notice of deficiency
- Follow HUD guidance and use HUDprovided documentation checklist
- Do not submit documentation which is not requested by HUD

Penalties for Non-Compliance

- PHAs may be subject to monetary penalties for the following actions:
 - Failure to use EIV
 - Failure to respond to HUD notice
 - Failure to submit HUD-requested documentation
 - Failure to recover identified improper payments
 - Failure to correct deficiency
 - Falsification of documentation
