Subject: Accessibility Requirements for Native American Programs: Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973; Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; Architectural Barriers Act of 1968; and Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988.

- **1. Extension.** This Notice extends Notice PIH 2010-27 (TDHE), same subject, which expires August 31, 2011.
- **2. Purpose.** The purpose of this Notice is to remind tribes and tribally designated housing entities (TDHE) who are recipients of federal funds of their obligation to comply with pertinent laws and implementing regulations that provide for non-discrimination and accessibility in federally funded housing and non-housing programs for people with disabilities.
