## Subject: Depository Agreements for Recipients of the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) Program.

**1. Extension.** This Notice extends Notice PIH 2010-31 (TDHE), same subject, which expires August 31, 2011. This Notice remains effective until amended, superseded, or rescinded.

**2.** Purpose. The purpose of this Notice is to extend Notice PIH 2010-31 which transmitted the current depository agreement forms to be used when investing IHBG funds; form HUD-52736-A (10/2004) for banking accounts and form HUD-52736-B (10/2004) for brokers/dealers. Also, the Notice clarifies when to use depository forms and when tribes or tribally designated housing entities (TDHEs) may utilize brokers in the investment of Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) funds under 24 CFR 1000.58.

**3.** Paperwork Reduction Act. The information collection requirements contained in this Notice have been approved by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (44 U.S.C. 3501 et seq.) and assigned OMB control number 2577-0218. In accordance with the Paperwork Reduction Act, HUD may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to, a collection of information unless the collection displays a currently valid OMB control number.
