Subject: Reinstatement – Depository Agreements for Recipients of the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) Program

This Notice reissues Notice PIH 2006-28 (TDHEs), same subject, which transmitted the depository agreements forms to be used when investing IHBG funds; form <u>HUD-52736-A</u> (10/2004) for banking accounts and form <u>HUD-52736-B</u> (10/2004) for brokers/dealers. The Notice clarified when to use depository forms and when tribes or tribally designated housing entities may utilize brokers in the investment of IHBG funds under 24 CFR 1000.58.
