Subject: Extension—Establishing a Micro Purchase Process for Purchases Less Than \$5,000 for Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) Recipients.

- 1. Extension. This Notice extends Notice PIH 2009-14 (TDHE), same subject, which expires on May 31, 2010 for another year, until May 31, 2011.
- **2. Purpose.** The purpose of this Notice is to reduce the burden of complying with the federal procurement process for goods and services of minimal cost. Specifically, Micro Purchasing allows a grantee to purchase goods and services costing less than \$5,000 without obtaining and documenting price quotes.
