**Subject:** Extension – PIH Notice 2008-6 (TDHEs) - Accessibility Requirements for Native American Programs: Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973; Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; Architectural Barriers Act of 1968; and Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988.

This Notice extends Notice PIH 2008-6 (TDHEs), same subject, which will expire on January 31, 2009, for another year until January 2010. Notice PIH-2008-6 reminds tribes and tribally designated housing entities (TDHEs) who are recipients of federal funds of their obligation to comply with pertinent laws and implementing regulations that provide for non-discrimination and accessibility in federally funded housing and non-housing programs for people with disabilities.
