Subject: Limiting Housing to Indian Families or Tribal Members When Using Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) funds.

This Notice extends Notice PIH-2008-08 (TDHEs), same subject, which will expire on January 31, 2009, for another year, until January 31, 2010. Notice PIH 2008-08 explained when tribes or tribally designated housing entities (TDHEs) (referred to in this Notice as 'Tribe') may limit housing assistance to Indian families or tribal members. The notice outlined how the requirements are different if only IHBG funds are used, or if IHBG funds are leveraged or combined with funds from other sources.
