Subject: Extension – PIH Notice 2007-32 Line of Credit Control System/Voice Response System (LOCCS/VRS) for the Indian Housing Block Grant Program.

This Notice extends Notice PIH-2007-32, same subject, which will expire on November 30, 2008, for another year until December 31, 2009. Notice 2007-32 provides guidance on the use of the LOCCS system for the IHBG program. LOCCS is a payment system used by varying HUD programs that provides grant recipients a system for requesting funds while providing ONAP a method to establish payment thresholds and review grant payment history. The extension of the Notice adds a reference to another PIH Notice regarding investments of IHBG funds.
