Errata Corrections as of May 8, 2012

- 1. On page 6, the following sentence has been updated: "Compared to the BCES12 case, natural gas generation in 2035 is about 11 percent higher and renewable generation is about 32 percent higher in an effort to meet the requirement with other qualifying sources." The previous version referred to preliminary no-nuclear run scenarios, and 11 percent was updated from 8 percent while 32 percent was updated from 40 percent.
- 2. On page 6, the following sentence has been slightly modified: "With nuclear power builds limited to plants already in the pipeline, ACP payments are more widely used than in the BCES12 case by 2035." This is an update from: "With nuclear power builds limited to plants already in the pipeline, ACP payments are widely used, in contrast to the BCES12".
