### **Project to Combat Exploitative Child Labor in Sugarcane Growing Areas of the Philippines**

**AGENCY:** Bureau of International Labor Affairs, Department of Labor.

**ACTION:** Correction. Amendment to SGA 11-04.

**SUMMARY:** The Department of Labor is publishing an amendment to SGA 11-04 *Project to Combat Exploitative Child Labor in Sugarcane Growing Areas of the Philippines* on [Grants.gov](http://Grants.gov) and the USDOL website. The solicitation was originally published on [Grants.gov](http://Grants.gov) and the USDOL website on July 14, 2011.

#### **Amendments:**

- On page 30, Section III.G., remove the sentence from **G. Application Package:**

Replace with the sentence:

- On page 38, Section III.H., remove the sentence from **H. Submission Date, Time, Address, and Delivery Method:**  
“Hard copy application must be delivered to U.S. Department of Labor, Procurement Services Center, 200 Constitution Avenue NW, Room S-4307, Washington, DC 20210, Attention: Brenda White, Grant Officer, Reference: Solicitation 11-XX.”  
Replace with the sentence:

- On page 39, Section III.H., remove the sentence from **H. Submission Date, Time, Address, and Delivery Method**

Replace with the sentence:

“Confirmation of receipt can be obtained from Brenda White and James Kinslow (see section VI. for contact information).”

- On page 39, Section III.I., remove the sentence from **I. Funding Restrictions, Unallowable Activities, and Specific Prohibitions**

Replace with the sentence:
