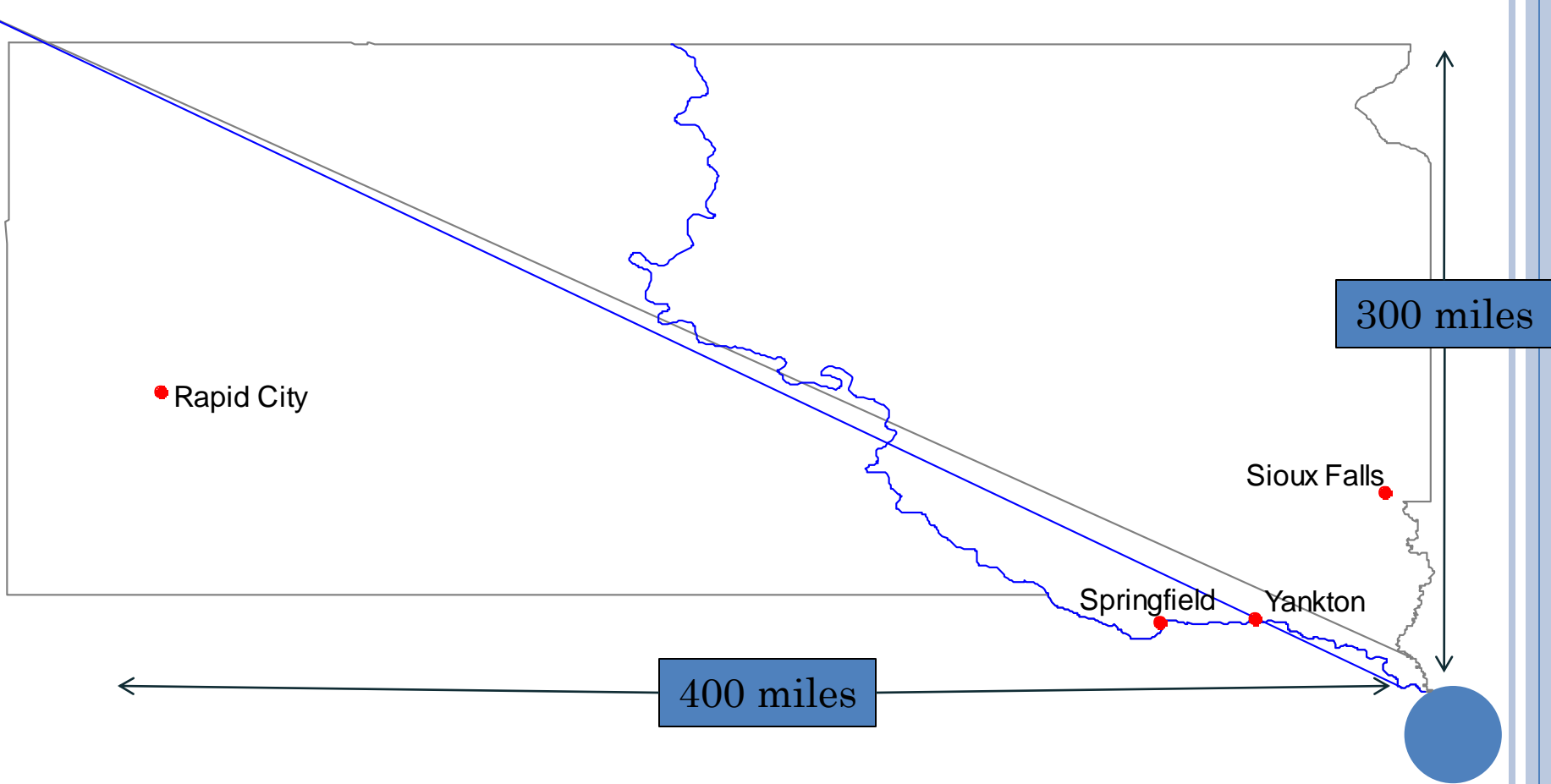

 - Voluntary Participation
 - Dad intends to be in a parenting role upon release from state facility
 - Not incarcerated for Domestic Violence
 - No current protection or restraining orders

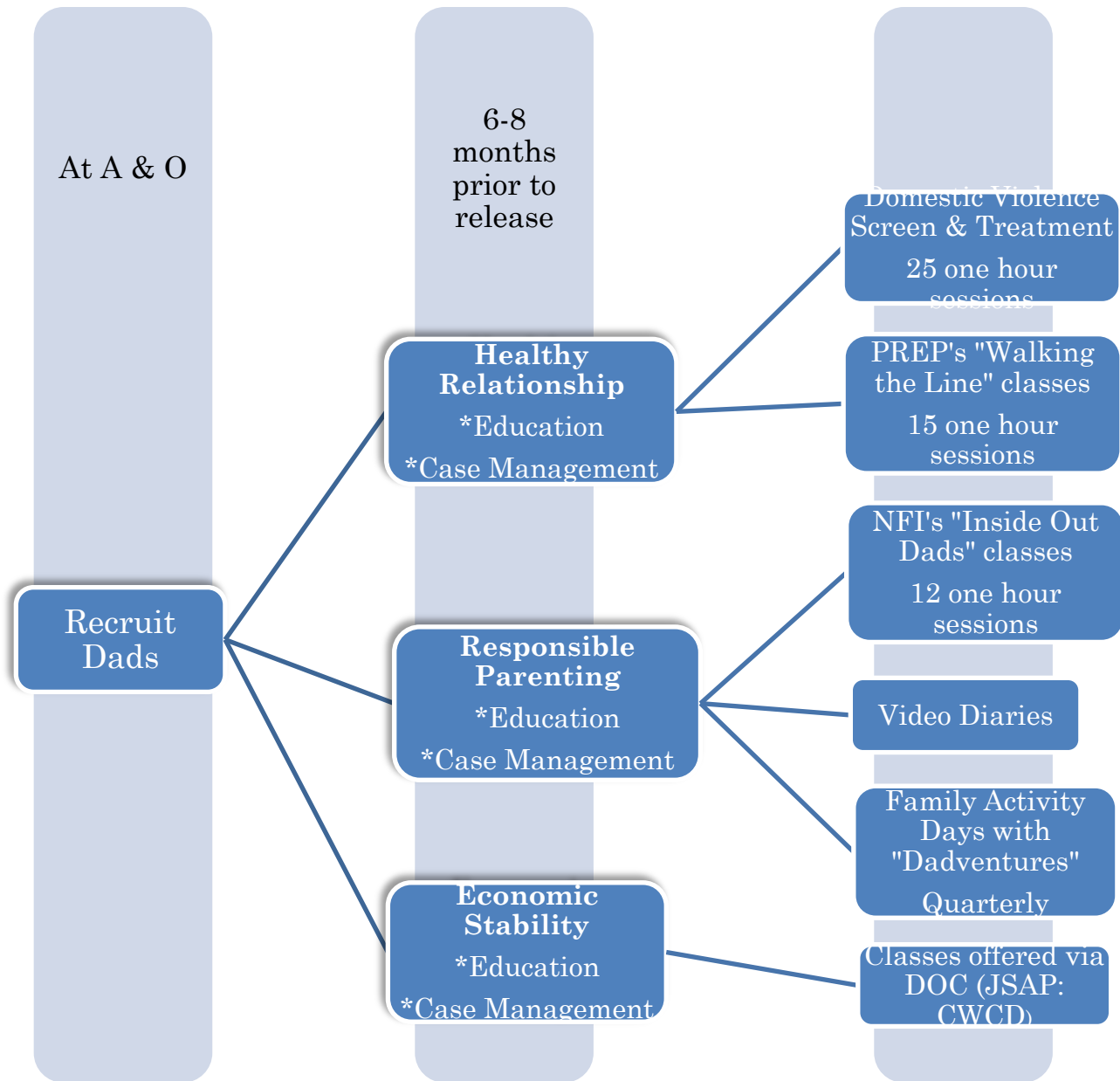

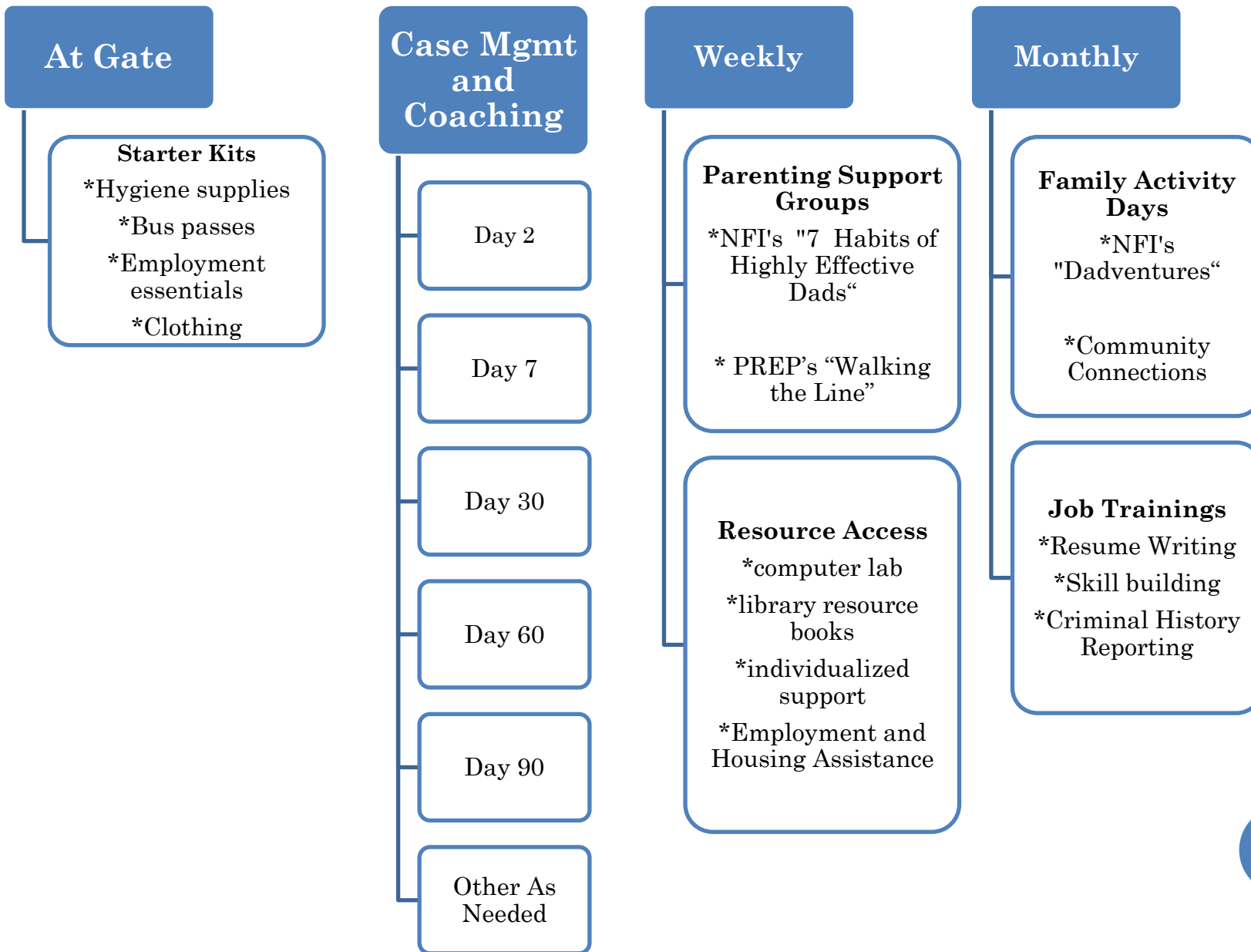
