The completion criteria for subjective incentives are focused on the achievement of high-level strategies, outcomes, and envisioned end states. The evaluation of all incentives will include a subjective determination regarding quality and effectiveness.

2. ALLOCATION OF AVAILABLE FEE

Because the services to be determined under this contract directly support the mission contractors, and because such services are integral to the environmental cleanup mission at Hanford, DOE will heavily weight the assignment of fee toward the following strategic areas of the contract: Worker health and well-being, customer satisfaction, and operational effectiveness. The objective performance incentives are allocated 70 percent of the available fee and the remaining 30 percent is allocated to the subjective performance incentives.

3. PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE RATINGS

Payment of fee is subject to the fee reduction terms of this contract, and fee determining official approval that the contractor has achieved the stated outcome for the specific performance incentive.
