The Hanford Advisory Board recommends that the Tri-Party Agreement Agencies should extend the M-33 Agreement in Principle Schedule by three months. The submittal of a signed change request from the Department of Energy to Washington State Department of Ecology and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency should be extended from December 31, 1995 to March 31, 1996 and negotiations should be extended from March 31, 1996 to June 30, 1996.
