FY12 Budget Assumptions/ Update




- A \$250K cut from FY11 level-funded Base funds from OCWWS.
- Assumes OST fully funds AWIPS-related activities for FY12.
- A \$250K cut from FY11 level-funded OOS NEXRAD funds.
- Assumes all OST & OOS system funds pay for their appropriate system training (e.g., ASOS, GSD).



IP12 Staffing Breakout 46 FTE + 37 (COMET/CIs/Contractors)








AWIPS II Training

- System Admin Deployment courses for ESA/ITO.
- Linux for WFO/RFCs Course pre-requisite for System Admin training.
- Applications Focal Point Training modules released for Deployment.
- OCWWS Base funds salaries of OCWWS FTE AWIPS trainers.
- OST AWIPS funds 5 CIMMS staff and travel: 4 at WDTB and 1 at NWSTC to develop Build training for new software releases.
- WES I / WES II Bridge support.

Aviation

Funded by OCWWS Aviation Services Branch (ASB) (\$300K):

- Module on Space Weather Impacts to Aviation
- DLAC-III Improving Aviation Weather Services

Active PDS team (led by Julie Adolphson & OCWWS ASB) defining priorities for CWSU, AWC and WFO with links to DSS

Marine

Funded:

- Nearshore Wave Modeling Module
- Communicating the Impacts of Extreme Marine Hazards DL Module

Active PDS team (led by OCWWS Marine Branch) defining priorities with links to DSS



Climate, Fire, Hydrology, Space Weather Training



Climate

Plan funds Climate Variability (Basic and Advanced) to NWS focal points.

Fire Weather

- IMET Workshop funded (\$155K).
- Fire Weather PDS team is finishing work.

Hydrology

- CHPS Training is highest priority.
- New Hydro PDS Team (\$64K for COMET/FDTB/NWSTC).

Space Weather

- COMET ® updating its basic space weather module.
- NWSTC work with SWPC "Handling Space Weather Inquiries" module.



Maintenance Training



- Dual-Pol Maintenance/Support/Outreach
- WRIP (Maintenance & Focal Point)
- RRS Maintenance (Attrition)
- ASOS Maintenance
- NWR Transmitter Maintenance (Armstrong 2010, Crown, Continental Crown, Nautel)
- Safety training (Environmental Compliance, Safety Training, Fall Protection Initial/Recert)
- Wind Profiler Deployment Support



Summary



- Training funding continues to be eroded by budget reductions and inflation.
- Mandatory training expenditures and classes deferred from FY11 have severely limited flexibility for Regional prioritization during NSTEP process.
- Strategic Training initiatives for NWS Services Roadmap underway with FY13 delivery.

IP12 Requirements




- 141 national training requirements were gathered as Performance Needs Statements (PNS).
- 78 requirements (55%) received resources.
- \$6M in unmet training requirements needs.
