Notes

- Aberrations, such as negative expenditure rates or those over 100%, usually result from errors or adjustments in 9130 reporting for prior periods being corrected in current period reports. They are a result of reporting on a cumulative basis and an ETA policy that limits the State's ability to correct quarterly reports.
