Pipe tobacco will be shown on the Monthly Statistical Release - Tobacco Products beginning with the January 1989 release.

Beginning with the January 1989 Monthly Statistical Release - Tobacco Products, cigarettes, cigars, snuff, and pipe tobacco shown under the category of Imported from Foreign Countries: Entered/Withdrawn for Consumption will be identified with the appropriate reference to the new Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTS), effective January 1, 1989. In addition, a new reporting format for large cigars under the category of Imported from Foreign Countries: Entered/Withdrawn for Consumption will be employed. The new format will aggregate cigars in statistical classes A through G. This change is necessitated because the information now comes in that format to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms from the Bureau of the Census (Publication IM146). Enquiries regarding the new reporting format should be directed to the Bureau of the Census.
