**Executive Order 13582 of August 17, 2011
Blocking Property of the Government of Syria and
Prohibiting Certain Transactions With Respect to Syria**

GENERAL LICENSE NO. 15


Certain Transactions Related to Patents, Trademarks, and Copyrights Authorized

(a) The following transactions that would otherwise be prohibited by Executive Order 13582 in connection with patent, trademark, copyright, or other intellectual property protection in the United States or Syria are authorized:

- (1) The filing and prosecution of any application to obtain a patent, trademark, copyright, or other form of intellectual property protection;
- (2) The receipt of a patent, trademark, copyright, or other form of intellectual property protection;
- (3) The renewal or maintenance of a patent, trademark, copyright, or other form of intellectual property protection; and
- (4) The filing and prosecution of any opposition or infringement proceeding with respect to a patent, trademark, copyright, or other form of intellectual property protection, or the entrance of a defense to any such proceeding.

(b) This general license authorizes the payment of fees currently due to the United States Government or the Government of Syria, or of the reasonable and customary fees and charges currently due to attorneys or representatives within the United States or Syria, in connection with the transactions authorized in paragraph (a) of this general license. Payment effected pursuant to the terms of this paragraph may not be made from a blocked account.

(c) Nothing in this general license affects obligations under any other provision of law.
