
INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

On or about August 5, 2011, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **SAMUEL JACKSON**, an Indian, did knowingly engage and attempt to engage in a sexual act with Jane Doe, a child known to the Grand Jury who had not attained the age of sixteen (16) years, and the sexual act consisted of the intentional touching, not through the clothing, of the genitalia of Jane Doe, with an intent to abuse, humiliate, harass, and degrade the victim, and to arouse and gratify the sexual desire of the defendant.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153, 2241(c), and 2246(2)(D).
