AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

I, David Smith, being duly sworn do hereby depose and swear as follows:

I am employed as a Special Agent with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) currently assigned to the Albuquerque District Office, Albuquerque, New Mexico.


This affidavit is made in support of a criminal complaint being filed against Cesar CARRASCO charging him with violating Title 21 USC 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(A) to wit: possession with intent to distribute 500 grams or more of methamphetamine.

On February 10, 2012, the DEA served a Federal Search Warrant at 9024 Blue Meadow Trail SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico. This is Cesar CARRASCO's residence. As a result of the search warrant, the DEA seized 5.05 gross kilograms of methamphetamine from the garage at 9024 Blue Meadow Trail SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico. The 5.05 gross kilograms was field tested by the DEA and tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine.


A Source of Information (SOI) had identified 9024 Blue Meadow Trail SW, Albuquerque, New Mexico, as a residence that the SOI had picked-up a half pound of methamphetamine from on February 7, 2012, or February 8, 2012. The SOI stated Marco JIMENEZ directed the SOI to this residence and when the SOI arrived at the residence, JIMENEZ's cousin, Cesar CARRASCO, delivered the half pound of methamphetamine to the SOI. The SOI believed that JIMENEZ was storing approximately 14 pounds of methamphetamine at this residence for JIMENEZ. This SOI is providing information in hopes of receiving a reduced sentence for a recent drug arrest. The SOI provided information to the agents regarding JIMENEZ and Javier VIDACA. The SOI did not know that agents possessed previous information regarding VIDACA and JIMENEZ. Based on the information regarding JIMENEZ and VIDACA, agents consider this SOI to be very reliable.

For the reasons set forth above, SA David Smith respectfully requests the court to approve this criminal complaint charging Cesar CARRASCO with violation of Title 21 USC 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(A), to wit: possession with intent to distribute over 500 grams or more of methamphetamine.

This affidavit is submitted for the limited purpose of providing probable cause to support the attached criminal complaint. I have not set forth each and every fact learned during the course of this investigation in the above affidavit. Affiant respectfully requests the approval of this criminal complaint for Cesar CARRASCO them with violating Title 21 USC 841, to wit: possession with intent to distribute over 500 grams or more of methamphetamine.
