INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about November 18, 2011, in Otero County, in the District of New Mexico and elsewhere, the defendants, WARREN BOYD MARKER and JAMES ROBERT FENDER, a/k/a "Moose," unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally did combine, conspire, confederate, and agree with each other and other persons whose names are known and unknown to the Grand Jury to commit the following offense against the United States, to wit: possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance, 5 grams and more of methamphetamine, contrary to 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846.

Count 2

On or about November 18, 2011, in Otero County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, WARREN BOYD MARKER and JAMES ROBERT FENDER, a/k/a "Moose,"

unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a controlled substance, 5 grams and more of methamphetamine.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § § 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.
