Program Justification Document Guidelines

IHS is in transition from using the Health Facilities Planning Manual (HFPM) to using the Health System Planning Process (HSP). The HFPM is a printed manual providing instructions for preparing IHS health care facilities construction planning documents. The HSP is an automated system to assist with preparing planning documents. A few facilities have been approved for preparing a Program Justification Document (PJD) using the HFPM. (See the memorandum "Health System Planning Process Implementation," dated June 2 1999.) As these facilities are completed the HFPM will be phased out. The PJD for all other facilities should be prepared using the HSP. Guidelines are provided for preparing a PJD using both the HFPM and the HSP.
