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## **SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS**

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### **PROPOSED RULE CHANGE**

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-99-46) under Rule 19b-4 under the Exchange Act relating to registration of chief compliance officers. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 2. (Rel. 34-43765)

### **APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE**
