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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### THOMAS MCKIBBIN BARRED, EQUITRUST REGISTRATION REVOKED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Thomas McKibbin and EquiTrust, Inc., a registered investment adviser located in Westerville, Ohio. McKibbin is EquiTrust's sole shareholder, officer, and director. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted McKibbin's and EquiTrust's Offer of Settlement in which they consented to the Commission's findings and sanctions contained in the Order. That Order bars McKibbin from association with any investment adviser, broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, or investment company and revokes EquiTrust's registration.

The Order finds that from at least May 1987 to May 1988, McKibbin routinely took custody and possession of client funds for investment in mutual funds, and misappropriated some of these funds for personal use. In addition, EquiTrust's books and records were non-existent, missing, or in disarray. The Order further finds that McKibbin and EquiTrust violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and the custody and possession and books and records provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. Finally, the Order finds that McKibbin and EquiTrust were permanently enjoined from violating these provisions based on the same activities as those described above. (Rel. 33-6834)

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## TRADING SUSPENSIONS

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### TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF WESTMINISTER FINANCIAL CORPORATION

The Commission announced the temporary suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Westminister Financial Corporation, a Delaware corporation, for the ten-day period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (EDT) on May 8 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on May 17.

The Commission suspended trading in the securities of Westminister because of the lack of adequate current information concerning the issuer, and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, its current financial condition, its assets and equity, the identity and background of its officers and affiliates, and other matters. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### GORDON E. HARRY ENJOINED

The San Francisco Branch Office announced that on April 20 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California entered an Order of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against Gordon E. Harry of Salt Lake City, one of the remaining defendants in a case involving the unregistered distribution and the market manipulation of the stock of DataForce International, Inc., a Panamanian corporation. The Order permanently enjoins Harry from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and orders him to disgorge \$71,168. ORDER OF CIVIL CONTEMPT OBTAINED AGAINST EDWIN D. WOOD II  
AND THE FRANKLIN GROUP INTERNATIONAL, INC.

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on April 26 Judge Benjamin F. Gibson, Western District of Michigan, entered an Order of Civil Contempt against Edwin D. Wood II and The Franklin Group International, Inc. The Order requires defendants to provide within 14 days an accounting to the Court of all funds received by them and all funds paid out or loaned by them since being enjoined by the Court on February 6. The Order also prohibits defendants from purchasing cashiers or traveler's checks without approval of the Court. The Order further provides for imprisonment if defendants fail to make the required accountings.

The Commission's March 15 Motion to Show Cause alleged that defendants transferred funds in the form of money orders, in violation of the freeze provisions of a previous court order. (SEC v. Edwin D. Wood II, et al., WDMI, Civil Action No. 89-30016CA, filed February 6, 1989). (LR-12080)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC. ; CENTRAL OHIO COAL COMPANY; CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until May 30 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24878, dated May 4: THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC. - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Commonwealth Gas Services, Inc. (COS) and Lynchburg Gas Company, whereby Columbia will transfer all of the common shares of Lynchburg, \$5 par value, to COS in exchange for COS's common stock, \$50 par value, on a ten for one basis to effect a merger of Lynchburg into COS; CENTRAL OHIO COAL COMPANY - subsidiary of Ohio Power Company, to return excess capital to Ohio Power through declaration of a dividend up to \$12 million on its common stock out of capital surplus; and CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY - a registered holding company, to issue and sell, from time to time through June 30, 1991, up to an aggregate of \$300 million of debentures, in one or more series, at competitive bidding in accordance with the alternative procedures to Rule 50 authorized by the Statement of Policy dated September 2, 1982 [Rel. 35-22623] or, alternatively, pursuant to an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under Subsection 50(a)(5).

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### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-89-9) to establish a demarcation time between day and evening foreign currency option specialist privileges. (Rel. 34-26770)
