## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

---

### FOIA APPEAL OF BENJAMIN T. WILLEY, JR.

The General Counsel sent a letter to Benjamin T. Willey, Jr., Esq., affirming in part and reversing in part the Freedom of Information Act Officer's determination to withhold information concerning Great American Partners. The General Counsel determined that, while some of the requested information should be released, the majority of the documents may be withheld pursuant to FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 USC 552(b)(7)(A), and the Commission's rule implementing that exemption, 17 CFR 200.80(b)(7). (Rel. FOIA-121)

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### MYSORE S. SUNDARA & ASSOCIATES, INC. AND MYSORE S. SUNDARA ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on July 18 U.S. District Judge James H. Alesia entered an Order adjudging Mysore S. Sundara and Mysore S. Sundara & Associates, Inc. in civil contempt for failure to provide the Commission with certain documents and records which were ordered to be produced by July 5. The Order imposes a fine against each of \$100 per day for each day that the documents and records are not produced. This fine increases by \$100 per day for each day of non-compliance with the Order. A status hearing has been set for August 4. (SEC v. Mysore S. Sundara & Associates, Inc., et al., USDC NDIL, Civil Action No. 89-C-4968). (LR-12183)

### JAMES P. HOLLIS, JR. ENJOINED

The Philadelphia Regional Office announced that on July 25 Judge Giles, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against James P. Hollis, Jr., enjoining him from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Hollis consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint.

The Complaint alleged that Hollis, through his wholly owned corporation, Plaza Consultant, Inc., located in Penndel, Pennsylvania, converted funds given to him by at least 14 clients for the purchase of securities. The Commission alleged that Hollis misappropriated at least \$494,276 by making false and misleading statements and omitting to state material facts regarding his intention to purchase securities for client accounts. The Commission also alleged that Hollis used investor funds for the payment of his personal and business expenses. The Commission further alleged that Hollis failed to register with the Commission as an investment adviser. (SEC v. James P. Hollis, Jr., EDPA, Civil Action No. 89-5522). (LR-12184)

### INDIANAPOLIS LIFE VARIABLE ACCOUNT A

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by Indianapolis Life Variable Account A for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17089 - July 26)

### ND TAX-FREE FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting ND Tax-Free Fund, Inc. and ND Capital, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 22(d), and Rule 22c-1 of the Investment Company Act to impose a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares. (Rel. IC-17090 - July 27)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed the following proposed rule changes: (SR-NASD-89-29) that would amend the examination specifications and study outline for the Direct Participation Programs Limited Representative (Series 22) qualifications examination. (Rel. 34-27065); (SR-NASD-89-28) that would amend the examination specifications and study outline for the Direct Participation Programs Limited Principal (Series 39) qualifications examination. (Rel. 34-27066); and (SR-NASD-89-27) that submits the examination specifications and study outline for the recently approved registration category of Assistant Representative - Order Processing. The Examination will be designated "Series 11." (Rel. 34-27067)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 24.

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
