CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION FILED AGAINST THOMAS E. MCREYNOLDS, OTHERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices filed a Complaint on August 25 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against Thomas E. McReynolds, Richard Lewis Hoffman, and Myron K. Berryman, seeking preliminary and permanent injunctions and other relief.

The Complaint alleges that McReynolds, former president of Jocom, Inc., a dissolved Utah corporation, and Hoffman, a registered representative with various broker-dealers, engaged in a distribution of Jocom stock in violation of the registration provisions of the Securities Act. Jocom stock traded in the over-the-counter market. The Complaint also alleges that McReynolds and Hoffman caused newsletters to be distributed and provided due diligence materials, including financial statements prepared by Berryman, to dealers making a market in Jocom stock. The newsletters and due diligence materials were materially false and misleading in that they contained misstatements regarding, among other things, the acquisition of various businesses by Jocom. The Complaint further alleges that Hoffman failed to disclose to investors that he dominated and controlled the market for Jocom stock, and was charging excessive mark-ups on the Jocom transactions. (SEC v. Thomas E. McReynolds, et al., Civil Action No. 89-6666-CIV-MARCUS, SDFL). (LR-12237)

FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST JACK N. POLEVOI

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on August 29 U.S. District Judge Robert J. Kelleher entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction, Disgorgement, and Imposition of Civil Penalties against Jack N. Polevoi. The Final Judgment was entered following the Court's granting of the Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment against Polevoi on August 21. The Motion for Summary Judgment was based on the undisputed facts that Polevoi was a corporate officer and insider of ZZZZ Best Co., Inc. (Z Best), and that between June 29 and July 1, 1987, Polevoi caused 54,200 shares of Z Best stock to be sold short while he was in possession of material nonpublic information. Judge Kelleher permanently enjoined Polevoi from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5, ordered that he disgorge \$224,860.75 in ill-gotten gains plus interest, and ordered that he pay a triple penalty of \$674,582.25 under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984.

Polevoi had pled guilty on June 9 to an indictment that included a charge that he had conspired to commit violations of the Exchange Act. He is currently incarcerated. (SEC v. Jack N. Polevoi, et al., Civil Action No. 89-1001 RJK [Sx], CDCA). (LR-12238)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALLIED CAPITAL CORPORATION

THE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF VIRGINIA

An order has been issued to The Life Insurance Company of Virginia, Life of Virginia Separate Account II, Life of Virginia Separate Account III, and Life of Virginia Separate Account 4 approving the substitution of securities issued by certain management investment companies and held by Account II and Account III to fund variable life insurance contracts and by Account 4 to fund variable annuity contracts. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
