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## NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

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Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted under provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

CLOSED MEETING - TUESDAY, OCTOBER 24, 1989 - 2:30 p.m.

The subject matter of the October 24 closed meeting will be: Settlement of administrative proceedings of an enforcement nature; Institution of injunctive actions; Dismissal of injunctive action; Regulatory matter regarding financial institutions; Consideration of amicus participation.

OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 25, 1989 - 2:00 p.m.

The subject matter of the October 25 open meeting will be:

(1) The Commission will consider (1) approval of a proposed rule change by the New York Stock Exchange to trade stock baskets on the NYSE Floor; (2) approval of a proposed rule change by the Chicago Board Options Exchange to trade stock baskets on the CBOE Floor; (3) approval of a proposed rule change and transaction reporting plan by the Midwest Stock Exchange to establish an after-hours trading session for the execution of transactions in portfolios of securities through its new automated Portfolio Trading System; (4) approval of two separate orders granting the NYSE unlisted trading privileges in stocks contained in the Standard and Poor's (S&P) 500 Index and granting the CBOE unlisted trading privileges in stocks contained in the S&P 100 and 500 Indexes that are not currently registered for trading on the NYSE and CBOE, respectively, for the limited purpose of trading market baskets; and (5) issuance of a Commission release proposing for comment adoption of new Rule 12a-7 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, which will exempt from Section 12(a) of the Act, solely for the purpose of market basket trading, securities included in a standardized market basket product approved by the Commission under Section 19(b) of the Act. (2) Consideration of an application filed by T. Rowe Price Associates, Inc. on behalf of T. Rowe Price Spectrum Fund, Inc. for a conditional Commission order under Sections 6(c), 17(b), and 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 of the Investment Company Act of 1940 to permit the Spectrum Fund to acquire shares of funds within the T. Rowe Price group of funds in excess of the limitations imposed by Section 12(d)(1) and to permit certain affiliated transactions otherwise prohibited by Sections 17(a) and 17(d). 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## CORPORATE REORGANIZATION RELEASES

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### SAHLEN & ASSOCIATES, INC.

On October 2, the Commission, in its statutory advisory role under the Bankruptcy Code, filed a brief in an appeal to the district court addressing the issue of whether indemnification of the legal defense costs of the debtors' current officers and directors to defend lawsuits arising out of their pre-petition conduct may be authorized as an administrative expense of the estate under Section 503(b)(1)(A) of the Code. The brief takes the position that these costs may be granted such administrative priority if the court finds, on the basis of the record, that the continued service of the officers and directors is beneficial to the estate and that the benefits to be derived from their continued service justify the amount of advances for legal fees. In this case, since no adequate showing was made, the Commission asserted that the matter should be remanded to the bankruptcy court for further proceedings. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### FIRST CHARTER LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by First Charter Life Insurance Company, First Charter Variable Annuity Account, and CNL, Inc., for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Central Power and Light Company, Public Service Company of Oklahoma, Southwestern Electric Power Company, West Texas Utilities Company, Transok, Inc., and Central and South West Services, Inc., to amend their short-term borrowing program, through March 31, 1991, to permit Transok to issue short-term notes to the CSW system money pool and banks, in outstanding amounts of up to \$120 million. 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## LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

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### WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of COMPUTER CONSOLES, INC. to withdraw its 7-3/4% convertible subordinated debentures, due 1998, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-27350)

### DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration the common stock, \$.05 par value, of TECHNODYNE, INC. (Rel. 34-27356)

### UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until October 31 to comment on the application of the following stock exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in the specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: Cincinnati Stock Exchange - 22 issues. (Rel. 34-27351); and the Midwest Stock Exchange - five issues. (Rel. 34-27353)

## UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of 37 issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. 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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSRB-89-6) that amends the Board's rule on professional qualifications by eliminating the Board's Financial and Operations Principal (FINOP) Examination and, thus, requiring FINOP candidates to qualify through the National Association of Securities Dealers' FINOP Examination. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of October 16. (Rel. 34-27349)

### TEMPORARY ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted temporary accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-89-29) which provides an exemption from the Compliance Official Qualification (Series 14) Examination for Specialists and "upstairs trading" organizations. (Rel. 34-27355)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-89-28) which provides an exemption from the Compliance Official Qualification (Series 14) Examination for those Exchange members and member organizations who generate public business income not in excess of \$500,000 in a calendar year, and who introduce all accounts to another broker/dealer. (Rel. 34-27357)

### AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Mid est Stock Exchange filed an amendment to a proposed rule change (SR-MSE-87-13) to modify its Co-Specialist Evaluation Questionnaire. (Rel. 34-27358)

### AMENDMENTS TO INTERMARKET TRADING SYSTEM PLAN

The participants of the Intermarket Trading System have filed amendments to the Plan for creating and operating an Intermarket Communication Linkage to (a) recognize the use of the "Regional Computer Interface" by the Boston Stock Exchange (Third Amendment); (b) allow for Pre-Opening Application to be based on the closing price on the New York Stock Exchange or the American Stock Exchange in certain circumstances (Eighth Amendment); (c) clarify that a specialist/market maker who has sent a Pre-opening response has a responsibility to seek a report of execution (Third Amendment); and (d) clarify the procedures for resolving third participating market center trade-throughs (Third Amendment). 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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### 3 BEALLS HOLDING CORPORATION

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by 3 Bealls Holding Corporation that the trusteeship of First Interstate Trust Company of New York under two Company indentures, and of Bankers Trust Company under two Company indentures, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Trust Companies from acting as trustee under their respective indentures. (Rel. TI-2230)

## ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
