COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

Pursuant to a subpoena issued by the House Banking, Finance and Urban Affairs Committee, Chairman Breeden will testify before that Committee on Tuesday, November 14 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building.

JOHN D. HEINE JOINS OPA STAFF

John D. Heine joins the Office of Public Affairs as Senior Public Affairs Specialist, effective today. Mr. Heine was Assistant Director, Office of Consumer Affairs and Information Services. He replaces Chiles Larson, who retired in June 1989.

POSSIBLE FEE INCREASE

Registrants and their representatives should be aware that sections of both authorization and appropriation legislation pending before Congress would, once signed into law, immediately amend current statutes regarding the percentage used to calculate filing fees. Under H.R. 3299, if adopted, the fees paid pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 13(e)(3) and 14(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 would be equal to 1/40th of 1% rather than the current 1/50th of 1%. S.1712 would raise only the fee under Section 6(b) to 1/40th of 1%. These fee changes will become effective upon enactment of either legislative proposal, and any filing not in compliance may not be accepted. The Commission will monitor these legislative initiatives and make an immediate announcement once either bill is signed into law.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES DON R. DASEKE

The Commission today filed a Complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia alleging that Don R. Daseke, principal of Daseke Management Company of America, a Dallas, Texas real estate management company, violated Section 13(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 13d-1 and 13d-2. Simultaneously Daseke, without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations, consented to an injunction.

The Complaint alleges that in a Schedule 13D filed on January 7, 1988 reporting Daseke's beneficial ownership of more than 5% of the outstanding securities of Southwest Realty Limited (SRL), a publicly-traded Texas limited partnership, Daseke stated, among other things, that he had no specific plans or proposals that relate to or would result in any extra-ordinary transaction, such as a merger or liquidation, when, in fact, Daseke had formulated a plan to acquire control of SRL and liquidate its assets. The Commission further alleges that in five Amendments to the Schedule 13D, which were filed between December 5, 1988 and January 30, 1989, Daseke failed to correct the original Schedule 13D disclosures, and in the Fifth Amendment, Daseke also failed to disclose his plan to pursue a tender offer for SRL securities. (SEC v. Don R. Daseke, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 89-3091). (LR-12293)
